## **Embleton Vincent Edwards Primary School Governing Body - Election of Parent Governor**

We currently have 2 vacancies for Parent Governors. The role of a school governor is to work in partnership with the Headteacher and other governors to raise standards and improve outcomes for all children at the school. They also decide on the strategic direction which the school takes by helping to decide the priorities for improving the school. Parent governors are directly elected by the other parents/carers to represent them on the Governing Body.

The post lasts for up to 4 years, and would involve attending meetings in the evenings (6 main meetings and a range of other smaller meetings as required, per year) and being able to come in to school a few times a term for governor monitoring meetings.
