### **AUTUMN TERM 2 - NEWSLETTER**

Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back after half term. We hope that you all had a good break. This half-term is a very busy one, with a whole range of activities and events. Make sure that you keep an eye on the diary on the school website so that you don't miss anything!

#### School Closure in the Case of Bad Weather

In the run up to winter it is important that you are all aware of the process if weather conditions are bad. If you think that school might not be open due to bad weather you must check the Northumberland County Council website, who are the official authority on whether a school is closed or not. If there are no details on the County Council website then you must assume that the school is open, and bring your child to school as normal. Whenever possible, we will also update the school website to let parents know.

If the school has to close due to worsening conditions, we will contact you by phone to come and pick up your child. Please make sure that your details are up to date! If we have notification of disruption to the taxi service for any reason we will also endeavour to let you know by phone.

#### **Cold Weather Clothing**

As the weather turns colder and damper, please ensure that your child comes to school with a waterproof coat every day, so that we can go outside if we want to. Please also ensure that your child has a pair of named wellies in school and, ideally, some waterproof trousers. This will mean that we will be able to access the field whatever the weather, and ensure that we don't have wet and muddy children inside! Don't forget named hats, scarves and gloves too, on those days when they are needed.

# Wraparound Care - Nursery

From January 2018 we will be offering wraparound care for children from Nursery upwards (rather than just Reception upwards) it is available from 7.30 am and until 5.30 pm daily. Please speak to the school office for further details.
