Nursery Places

From September 2017 we will be offering a more flexible approach to our nursery provision. Parents will be able to choose either full days (8.45am - 3.00pm) or half days (8.45am - 11.45am or 12pm - 3.00pm). We will also be offering the opportunity for people to pay beyond their 'free' entitlement of 15 or 30 hours. Charges will be £10 for a half day and £18 for a full day. Please let us know if you have a child hoping to come to our nursery, or if you have any questions regarding our offer.
