AUTUMN TERM 1 - NEWSLETTER

Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you had a lovely summer holidays, and that all the children are back to school refreshed and raring to go. We have been very busy over the holidays clearing out the school – we managed to fill 2 skips with obsolete or old equipment and resources! We have refreshed most areas, repainted parts, and reset. We are very proud of how the school looks, and hope that you are too.

I would like to welcome Mrs Popay formally to the permanent teaching staff. Although she worked with us for much of last year, she had done so on a temporary basis. It is also great to have Mrs Cotton now working full-time in the school, and we are delighted that Mrs Davison is continuing to work with us for a couple of days a week as a volunteer whilst she completes her training.

Wraparound Care

We are really excited this term to be offering wraparound care for children from Reception upwards. It is available from 7.30 am and until 5.30 pm daily. This is in addition to the daily clubs that will also continue. Please speak to the school office for further details.

PE - Years 1 to 5

Years 1 to 5 will go to Willowburn each week on Monday for swimming and an activity. This half-term the activities are either trampolining or gymnastics. Please ensure that swimming costumes come in to school on a Monday. Children can come to school in their PE kit, but must remember to bring school uniform to change in to at lunchtime. PE kit needs to remain in school all week, as it may be used on other occasions. It will be sent home on Fridays.

PE – Reception & Nursery

Children in Early Years will have plenty of opportunities to use the hall and outside space for PE throughout the week. They do not need PE kits in school.

School Uniform

The school uniform list is on the website. Please ensure that it is adhered to. Please note that whilst a school tie is available for those KS2 children that want to wear them, there is no requirement to do so – a white shirt and school jumper is fine.







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From this term the wearing of jewellery, with the exception of a watch, will be forbidden. This includes earrings, as there is a danger of them being ripped out during playground activities or lost.

Parents are reminded that should a child want their ears pierced, the ideal time to do so is at the start of the summer holidays. If there are any specific religious or cultural reasons that conflict with the school uniform policy please make an appointment to speak to me about it.
