Class Organisation for Sept 18

I am sure most of you are keen to know how we are going to organise the classes next year. With the appointment of an additional part-time teacher, Miss Thompson, we are able to split the children into 3 classes for much of the time. Miss Thompson is an experienced teacher, who lives in Seahouses, and is currently working at a primary school in Ashington.

Based on pupil numbers, and our knowledge of your children, we will be splitting the classes:

- Year 1, 2 and 3 - Miss Murray and Mrs Hunter
- Year 4, 5 and 6 - Miss Thompson and Mrs Borrego

I will spend some time in each classroom covering when the class teacher is unavailable, and taking small groups out to do more focussed work.

Swimming and PE

This half term we will continue to go to Willowburn on a Monday morning with Key Stages 1 and 2. The PE activities for the children this half-term are athletics or the bouldering wall, and swimming. Please continue to send your child to school in PE kit on that day.

Beach School

We will continue to attend Beach School every Friday. Please make sure that your child has sun cream and gloves / hat in their bag each week - we have been caught out a couple of times. We will help children re-apply their sun cream at lunchtime if necessary. Please also make sure that they have waterproofs and wellies each week. If everything comes in every week, then we can make an assessment based on the activities we are doing, and what the weather forecast is, and ensure that we take the correct items with us.

Please make sure that your child continues to wear full school uniform when in school. The PE kit is nearly ready too so, once it is issued, please ensure that your child wears that for all occasions where ordinary school uniform is not required.
