Mathematics

Year 1

This half term year 1 will be focusing on place value and numbers up to 50. We will be ordering and comparing numbers using the language of more, less, fewer, greater, equal to. We will also be looking and addition and subtraction. We will be using lots of resources to help us so that our maths is fun and practical. This will help us to build our fluency before moving onto more formal written maths.

Year 2

Year 2 will be reinforcing their place value up to 50 and looking at numbers up to 100. We will be partioning numbers using place value charts and bar models. We will also be looking and ordering and comparing numbers, as well as reinforcing our times tables. We will be looking at addition and subtraction; initially using resources for support before moving on to more formal written methods.

PE

On a Monday we will be doing some basic gymnastics and we will be doing some throwing and catching skills down at the beach.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be looking at healthy eating. We will be thinking about how to keep our bodies clean and healthy including making sure we know how to wash our hands properly as well as



knowing how important it is to brush our teeth regularly.



RE

In RE, we will be looking at the question; How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter? We will think about ways in which we can look after our world, as well as thinking of ways in which we can help others. We will read some bible stories about

helping others such as The Good Samaritan and taking a look at the work of Mother Teresa.


History—Nursing

During our topic this half term we will be looking at famous historical figures within the field of nursing to link in with our science and PSHE topic of My Body and Me. We will look at the life and works of famous nurses such as Mary Seacole, Edith Cavell and Florence Nightingale. Science—Ourselves

English

This half term we will mainly be focusing on handwriting and sentence structure. We will be making sure we can all write sentences which include a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces.

Art—Portraits



In Art this half term we will study some portraits and learn how to read a portrait. We will also be having a go at drawing a self-portrait, learning how to get our features the right

shape, size and proportion. We will also look at some work by artists Leonardo Da Vinci and Guiseppe Arcimboldo.

Computing

In computing this half term we will be focusing on making sure all the children are familiar with the apps we use most often in school; mainly reading eggs and numbots, and making sure they can log on independently. Year 2 will also begin to learn how to use the keyboard and how to type using the correct fingers!

Music

This half term, in Music, Mrs Popay will be teaching us. She will be exploring the theme of 'How can we make friends when we sing together?'. We will also be learning how to keep the beat or pulse. This is the 'heartbeat' of every piece of music.
