ART - PRINTING

Making a print involves transferring an image from one surface to another. This process can result in repeating identical images over and over again.

Artist study - William Morris

William Morris was a designer who created wallpaper, inspired by nature, during the Victorian period, when it was only affordable for the very rich. He used block printing to create his repeating patterns.
