Nut-Free School

As mentioned in my email, we are now a nut-free school. Please do not send in your child with any products that contain nuts. If you have any queries about specific items please let me know.

Covid-19

We will continue to monitor, taking advice from the Local Authority and the Government, will continue to assess the risks, and amend procedures as appropriate. Please ensure that if your child is self-isolating as a result of having symptoms, or because they have been told to do so by an external agency, you tell us immediately (even at the weekend). This allows us the maximum amount of time to switch to online learning for your child, and ensures that all other procedures are followed in a timely manner.

Please be aware that, as before, we cannot socially distance your children from each other, and it is often a challenge for the staff to socially distance from your children too. However, we are continuing to ensure that we do as much as possible to minimise risks, and reduce the number of different children and adults your children come into contact with.

As discussed in my email, please ensure that your child has waterproofs and wellies in every day so that we can vacate the classrooms regularly, as well as appropriate other clothing for the conditions (inside and outside). We are continuing to minimise things being brought in from home, so again please do not bring book bags or other items to school.


Homework

Over the summer we have reviewed how we are doing homework. We recognise that people have busy lives and sometimes struggle to fit some bits of homework in. As a result, we are adopting the following homework schedule:

- Starfish (Reception) daily reading / word pots and Numbots 3 times a week. Topic work on an ad hoc basis given on Tapestry.
- Puffin daily reading and Numbots / Time Table Rock Stars (TTRS) 3 times a week. A single piece of homework on Google Classroom each week.
- Seal and Orca daily reading and TTRS 3 times a week. A single piece of homework from a half-termly menu on Google Classroom each week.

We prefer bookings in advance, although can take additional children on a short notice basis if you are stuck. We will continue with clubs for Puffins, Seals and Orcas Tues-Thu each week.

PE – Years 1 to 6

PE will continue to be on a Thursday afternoon. This half term we have Grant Watson coming in to school to teach tennis to the children in Puffin, Seal and Orca classes. Please send your children in to school in their PE kit in the morning. Tennis will take place outside, so please ensure that your child has their hoody, joggers and trainers. Swimming, for Seals and Orcas, is planned to start in January 2022.

Music

Mr Easton will be coming in to do general music lessons with children in Puffin and Starfish classes, and will be teaching guitar to Seals and Orcas this year. He will be in school on Wednesday mornings.

Beach School

We will be continuing to attend Beach School every Friday. Please ensure that children wear school PE kit to come to school. We will be staying down at the beach at lunchtime. As ever, we will continue to assess the weather and conditions each week, and will adjust our sessions accordingly, whether that be by working in the dunes, going to a sheltered spot on the beach, going down slightly later, or coming back earlier. Please be aware that shower-proof cagoules are not sufficient as the weather turns more Autumnal! Additionally, can I please ask that the hats that are used do not have large bobbles on the top, as it is very challenging to put up hoods and keep heads warm and dry. Please make sure that your child has both wellies and trainers in school on Fridays, as your child needs something to wear on their feet, other than wellies, in the classroom.
