Embleton Expects

Last year we worked with the children to create a charter called 'Embleton Expects', where the children looked at all the things that would help them to be successful at school. We will be continuing to focus on it this year, and would appreciate it if you could support us by reminding and encouraging your children to complete any work they do at home in accordance with our charter. Home-School Agreement

Enclosed is a Home-School Agreement. We would be grateful if you could read through it with your child, before both signing and returning it to school by Friday 7th September. Once we have taken a copy for our files we will return the original to you.

Knowledge Organisers

As part of our continuing drive to increase standards throughout the school, we will be sharing 'Knowledge Organisers' with the children, parents and carers. These will detail all the 'powerful' knowledge for a particular topic or module.

These are the 'go-to' documents outlining the essential knowledge that the teachers will be covering across a unit of work; including dates, key personnel, vocabulary, definitions, and other contextual or technical information. The aim is that everyone will then know exactly what is being taught, and what the children need to learn.

Children will initially use the Knowledge Organisers as prompt sheets, and over the course of the topic they will gradually be withdrawn until the children know all the information on them. Please feel free to also use them as reference guides for what your child is learning, and also as an opportunity to discuss facts about the topic and how much they have learnt. If you see any information on the Knowledge Organisers where you might be able to help with artefacts or discussions then please let us know!







Wraparound Care

We continue to offer wraparound care from 7.30 am, and until 5.30 pm. Please speak to Melissa if you would like to book any sessions. We prefer bookings in advance, although can take additional children on a short notice basis if you are stuck.

PE - Years 1 to 5

This half term Years 1 to 5 will go to Willowburn each week on a Thursday afternoon for swimming. Please ensure that children wear school uniform but bring in swimming costumes, towels and a water bottle on a Thursday.

Beach School

We will be continuing to attend Beach School every Friday. Please ensure that children wear school PE kit to come to school. As the weather is becoming more changeable please ensure that warm, waterproof coats, hats, waterproof trousers, and gloves (preferably waterproof) are available every week. Please also ensure your child has a water bottle. We will be doing PE lessons on the beach, so please make sure that both wellies and trainers are also in school.

School Uniform

The school uniform list is on the website, and in Year 6 planners. Please ensure that it is adhered to. Please note that whilst a school tie is available for those KS2 children that want to wear them, there is no requirement to do so – a white shirt and school jumper is fine.

Please note that the wearing of jewellery, with the exception of a watch, is not allowed. This includes earrings, as there is a danger of them being ripped out during playground activities or lost. Children with long hair are asked to have it tied back.

If there are any specific religious or cultural reasons that conflict with the school uniform policy please make an appointment to speak to me about it.
