ART - CLAY

Clay is a fine-grained mineral made when rocks break down. Wet clay is soft and can be rolled, stretched, moulded and shaped to make pottery, bricks and other things. When it is shaped, it is left to dry and becomes hard and fragile. It can then be painted and decorated.

Relief	Three dimensional parts of an artwork that are joined to a flat base
