Homework Expectations

Logging on

All children in key stage 2 are able to independently log on to all of the sites, they do this regularly in school especially TTRS and Google Classroom.

If you require a copy of passwords please let the class teacher know.

Boom Read (formally Go Read)

Key stage 2 children are able to login to and log their reading at home.

Orca class can independently log their own reading. They will have access to two reading books, a home reading book and a school one.

These books are set to the appropriate level for the reading ability. Previously we have used free reading books but found that the terminology and vocabulary were not always challenging enough especially for upper key stage 2 children. When we return to school children will be able to choose a library book of their choice also which they can read at their leisure if they would like to.

Orca Spellings



Weekly spelling tests will take place. Children will be given spellings on a Friday to be tested the following friday.

Paper copy of spellings will be given on Friday.

There is no expectations for spellings to be 'handed in or returned'.

These spellings will be set appropriately for your child, please note in year 6 there is a spelling test which covers spellings learnt from year 3,4,5 and 6.

Children are not expected to get 10/10 each week, I simply require them to try.

Seal Spellings



Children will be given spelling work on a Friday that is linked to the spelling list that they have been learning that week. Weekly spelling checks will take place on the following Friday.

The children will be given these independent tasks to complete at home to apply their learning on paper. They have been shown how to complete these in class.

These spellings will be set appropriately for your child, please note in year 6 there is a spelling test which covers spellings learnt from year 3,4,5 and 6.

Children are not expected to get 10/10 each week, this is something that allows me to see which spelling rules we need to revisit.

Topic

Half term topic homework will be given. This will be based on a specific topic - for example their topic for the half term, it may be a history, geography or science topic.

This will be posted on Google Classroom and be given as a paper copy to take home.

This is to be completed independently, all homework that is set is the children are able to complete.

Within school children complete independent research activities, the skills which they learn in school are transferable for their homework activities.
