Autumn Half Term 1 Newsletter

We hope that you had a fabulous summer. All the staff would like to thank you for the kind gifts you gave us at the end of last term - it is very thoughtful of you. We are looking forward to, and excited for, the new term. We have lots planned for the children.

Timings of the School Day

Doors open at 8.30 am. Please ensure that your child comes in promptly, so that they can get on with their morning tasks. The doors will close at 8.40 am, by which time we expect all children to be in and starting their lessons. School finishes at 3.10 pm.

Parking at School

Please do not use the side road to park or drop off your children at the beginning and end of the day. The road is required to be left clear so that the school taxis can safely embark and disembark children. Please try not to park on the main road below school, as it impedes two-way traffic - if at all possible please try and park on Front Street or Sea Lane.

Homework and Reading

Homework and reading books will be given out on a Thursday each week. Homework is a key component of your child's learning process and is to be completed every week. Please see below for the homework expectations for your child. All children from Reception upwards should read at least 4 times a week to an adult.

Absences

You may have seen in the media that the government is paying close attention to the number of absences from school that children have. If you are unsure whether you should send your child into school please give us a call and we can discuss it. In many instances a sniffle or disturbed night does not mean they need to be off school the next day.

Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC)

You may have seen in the media concerns about RAAC in schools. The question from the government was first posed to us in February 2019, and it formed part of a questionnaire that we had to fill in in early 2021, prior to an audit by the government of school real estate. Our school was not built using RAAC.

Parent Governors

Wraparound

We continue to offer wraparound care from 7.30 am, and until 5.30 pm. Please speak to Melissa if you would like to book any sessions. We prefer bookings in advance, although we can take additional children on a short notice basis if you are stuck.

Puffins will be doing PE on **Mondays**. Please ensure that your child wears a school PE kit to school on Mondays.

Seals and Orcas will be doing PE with Newcastle United Foundation on **Wednesdays.** Please ensure that your child wears a school PE kit to school on Wednesdays.

Beach School

This year we will be attending Beach School on **Fridays.** Please ensure that children wear school PE kit to come to school. We will be staying down at the beach at lunchtime. As ever, we will continue to assess the weather and conditions each week, and will adjust our sessions accordingly, whether that be by working in the dunes, going to a sheltered spot on the beach, going down slightly later, or coming back earlier. Please be aware that shower-proof cagoules are not sufficient as the weather turns more Autumnal! Additionally, can I please ask that the hats that are used do not have large bobbles on the top, as it is very challenging to put up hoods and keep heads warm and dry. Please make sure that your child has both wellies and trainers in school on Fridays, as your child needs something to wear on their feet, other than wellies, in the classroom.
