

Primary School Sports Premium 2022-23

This document will create a plan to help ensure that funds are targeted systematically to achieve maximum impact in school.

We will target funds and monitor impact by:

- Enhancing the PE provision for children
- Setting a new standard in children's activity levels
- Meeting the inclusion requirements and the value for money criteria which will be set by Ofsted

Our main focuses for the year will be:

- to continue to deliver and enhance weekly beach school sessions accessed by the
 whole school where all children walk the 3 miles to and from the beach; learn about
 the environment and our impact on it, gain a sense of wellbeing from being in the
 outdoors; gain an understanding about the importance of being physically active,
 regardless of whether one is playing sport; use and enjoy their local environment.
 (DfE requirement engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity, broader
 experience of a range of sports and physical activities)
- 2. continue to offer a range of sports, supported by qualified coaches (DfE requirement increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport)
- 3. support inter-school sporting activities, by taking part in competitions as part of Alnwick Small Schools (DfE requirement engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity, increased participation in competitive sport)
- 4. provide catch-up swimming to those children in UKS2 who have not achieved the standard of the national curriculum by the end of Year 4.
